Know All Men By These Presents: That we, the under-
signed Southern States Land and Timber Company, a cor-
poration under the laws of the State of Louisiana, by our
Attorneys, George S. Bessell and H. S. Fairchild, of the City
of West Palm Beach, in Palm Beach County, Florida, the
owners, respectively, of all of the lands within the bound-
aries of Lexahatchee Sub. Drainage District, a drainage dis-
trict organized and created under Chapter 6458 of the laws
of the State of Florida, by decree of the Circuit Court in and
for said County, dated April 4, 1917, covering and embracing
the following described lands in said County of Palm Beach,
Florida, to wit:

All of Sections Seventeen (17), Eighteen (18), Nineteen (19),
Twenty (20) and Twenty-one (21), and the Northwest quarter
and West half of Northeast quarter of Section Twenty-two
(22); and West half of West half of Section Twenty-seven (27);
and all of Sections Twenty-eight (28), Twenty-nine (29) and
Thirty (30) and all of Section Thirty-one (31) North of Palm
Beach Canal; and all of Section Thirty-two (32) North of Palm

by said District since its creation to the date of these presents including all orders, decrees and proceedings in connection with its creation and organization; "The Plan of Reclamation" as adopted by said District; the assessments of benefits and detriments made on the lands in said District by the Commissioners as shown by their report approved by the Court; all taxes and assessments of every nature and kind assessed or levied on any of the lands in said District for any and all purposes in connection with or for the benefit of said District, and the annual installments thereof directed to be paid; the issue of \$50,000.00 of bonds of said District, and all taxes that now or hereafter may be levied to meet the same or any interest thereon; the contract assigned to said District and acquired by it from Southern States Land and Timber Company for the excavation of the ditches and canals in said District and all of the terms and provisions of said contract; and also the instrument in writing under and by which said contract was assigned to said District and all of the terms and provisions of such said assignment; and also all other acts, things, transactions, proceedings and matters done, had or taken by said District since its organization to the present date; and the undersigned hereby in every manner and respect whatsoever, for themselves, their heirs, successors, legal representatives and assigns, do hereby waive each and every objection and all rights that they might otherwise now or hereafter have to object to the organization of said District or any act done or attempted to be done by said District since its organization in so far as the same may in any manner be subject to affect or bind any of their lands in said District above described, or otherwise; but without any thing herein contained being construed as an obligation on the part of any of the undersigned to assume to be personally responsible for the corporate debts, obligations or liabilities of said District now or hereafter contracted.

Right Of Way Deed.

This Indenture, made and executed this 3d day of June, A. D. 1918, by and between Southern States Land & Timber Company, a corporation under the laws of the State of Louisiana, duly authorized and licensed to do business in the State of Florida, hereinafter called the Grantor, which term shall include its successors, legal representatives and assigns wherever the context hereinafter so requires or admits, and Foxahatchee Sub. Drainage District, a sub-drainage district organized and created under Chapter 458 of the laws of the State of Florida, hereinafter called the Grantee, which term shall include its successors, legal representatives and assigns wherever the context hereinafter so requires or admits.

Witnesses: That, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars in cash and other good and valuable considerations to it moving from the Grantee, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the Grantor does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, a right of way, of the widths hereinafter respectively designated and specified, over on and across those certain parcels of land, in Township 22 N., Range 30 E., Sec. 10, Salt in Calumet Beach County, Florida, described under Section (1) separate items in group of...
