FINAL JUDGMENT AFTER DEFAULT NUNC PRO TUNC

This cause came before the Court on January 5, 2015, on Plaintiff Mount Sinai Allograft Technologies' ("Mount Sinai") Motion for Entry of Final Judgment After Default *Nunc Pro Tunc* ("Motion"), and the Court recognizing that a partial final judgment was entered on October 27, 2014 against Defendants TissueNet Distribution Services, LLC and TissueNet Custom Applications, LLC and that Defendant Alan Novotny was dismissed from this action on December 8, 2014,

and the Court having reviewed the Motion and heard argument of counsel, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

- 1. Final judgment is hereby entered in favor of Plaintiff Mount Sinai (whose address is Mount Sinai Hospital, 600 University Avenue, Room 19-309, Toronto, Ontario, Canada M5G 1X5) and against Defendants TissueNet Custom Applications, LLC and TissueNet Distribution Services, jointly and severally, in the amount of \$282,430.29 for breach of contract damages, which are inclusive of \$86,948.75 in damages against TissueNet Distribution Services, LLC for worthless checks, together with prejudgment interest (through October 28, 2014) in the amount of \$4,496.38, together with costs in the amount of \$860.88 and attorney's fees in the amount of \$8,742.50 for a total of \$296,530.05, all to bear interest at the statutory rate from October 27, 2014 until paid and for all of which sums let execution issue *nunc pro tunc* from October 27, 2014 forward.
- 2. In addition, final judgment is hereby entered in favor of Mount Sinai and against TissueNet Distribution Services, LLC, in the amount of \$260,855.25 of statutory special damages pursuant to § 68.065, Fla. Stat. (2014), for which let execution issue *nunc pro tunc* from October 27, 2014 forward.
- 3. It is further ordered and adjudged that the judgment debtors shall complete under oath Florida Rule of Civil Procedure Form 1.977 (Fact Information

Sheet), a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A," including all required

attachments, and serve it on the judgment creditor's attorney, or the judgment

creditor if the judgment creditor is not represented by an attorney, within 45 days

from the date of this final judgment, unless the final judgment is satisfied or post-

judgment discovery is stayed.

4. Jurisdiction of this case is retained to enter further orders that are

proper to compel the judgment debtor(s) to complete form 1.977, including all

required attachments, and serve it on the judgment creditor's attorney, or the

judgment creditor if the judgment creditor is not represented by an attorney.

5. This final judgment shall be effective nunc pro tunc to October 27,

2014, the date of the entry of partial final judgment against these within

Defendants.
